DISPENSIBILITY OF THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION

Sound knowledge of both biblical and systematic theology cum management is sine – qua – non – to successful ministry. Theological and ministerial education is indispensable to ministers for the following reasons

- 1. Theological training develops or makes the latent potentials in us to sprout and throb.
- Education is defense, because no person can fall below his level of education. Theological training also maximizes your God – given potentials in the ministry.
- 3. Education is a discovery process: Discovery brings about recovery, while recovery gives birth to a vision. Vision gives birth to power; and power brings about a mission. Mission itself gives rise to success and success brings abundant life that Jesus spoke about.
- 4. Theology is a science: as a science, it needs a laboratory with test tubes, weighing balances, other catalysts and acid tests for experiments.
- 5. It is investigative and logical: it needs a high sense of reasoning, questioning and collective reportage approach to arrive at an end.
- 6. It is psycho-philosophical: therefore, it needs a research and scientific approach, with mental discipline.
- 7. It is Geo-historical: it needs excavation of past histories and visit to the holy land; it retains traditions of the church for future generations.
- 8. It is socio-political: it needs knowledge of government and human knowledge of government and human interaction relationship, which is sinequa-non-to life.
- 9. It is eco-geological: it needs the knowledge of agriculture and mineral developments.

- 10. It is cosmos-firmamental:- it deals with the planetary systems and glacial institutions and their fabrics, strata or foundation.
- 11. It is pneumatic-revelation: It is Holy Spirit oriented and the hall mark of divine capability and achievement. So there is already enormous release of anointing for 21st century through theological education.
- 12. It is Theo-centric, Christo-centric and Spirito-centric:-its hallmark and zero point is God and it should be deitally pinpointed and strategize. God Himself is a teacher and the first ever teacher. Job 36:22.
- 13. It is lingua –academic:- it needs the sound study of languages e.g. English and French as our lingua franca and Hebrew and Greek for Hermeneutics and homiletics. As a minister or Christian worker, you should develop your communication semantics. As you preach, you are teaching. So realize the fact that as a teacher your academic and preaching involves a lot of academic work in order to evoke the interest of your numerous and diversified audience.
- 14. It is socio economic:- it deals with human or public relations even with God, and talks about how to be promoted and be wealthy for a buoyant economic enhancement. So theological education can feed you and your family.
- 15. It is profession like law and medicine:- if you believe it and as it is true we should study theology as we approach other professions. It is pneuma psycho- somatic it deals with the total man unlike other disciplines which deal with the partial man.
- 16. It is the corner –stone of the church foundation:- Jesus was referred to as Rabbi (meaning teacher) more than a shepherd (pastor) in the bible. Besides, He taught His disciples before they graduated to belong to the five-fold

ministry. So theological teacher is the father of the pastor, evangelist, apostle and prophet. Also theological education is more important than church administration, since it is the bedrock of church foundation. Why? Every pastor, prophet, evangelist, apostle was taught by the teacher. So it is high time we recognized the importance of teaching prophets. Hence the need for balanced theological education/training cannot be over emphasized. So have a divine and professional respect and recognition for theological educationists, if we have to prioritize things rightly as our master Jesus Christ.

DISTANCE LEARNING POLICY

Both educational methods offer a unique off-campus study approach. It is a combination of the traditional and independent study methods that provide educational goals for the individual.

PHILOSOPHY OF STUDENT GROWTH

It is our firm conviction that God wants every believer to become more like Christ.

This necessitates prioritising change above other interests. BIU is committed to being a place that fosters personal growth in an intentional way. Students are encouraged to identify areas that they need to improve in, implement strategies to see real change and evaluate their progress. This is done in a friendly environment where exposed weaknesses are viewed as growth opportunities rather than reasons for rejection. Serving God's purpose in your life is our highest honour.

- B. Contributors to Growth

The following are some of the things that have proven to assist students in their development:

1. Impartation: We believe in the power of impartation. Often there are key moments when the Holy Spirit imparts specific grace to us through a wide variety of means. At BIU, this seems to happen regularly in classes, devotion, prayer times and counseling sessions. For this reason, we ask all students to be faithful in attending all of these with an expectant heart.

2. Accountability: Accelerated growth usually doesn't happen without accountability outside of ourselves. This is a dynamic tool that can motivate us beyond our own limitations. Students are asked to be accountable in a variety of areas not as a sign of a lack of trust but as a proponent of progress in their lives. This involves an honour system that presumes a sincerity on the part of the student to desire integrity above merely satisfying a system's requirements.

3. Mentoring: Perhaps as a reminder of the necessity of humility, God has arranged things so that we often are dependent on the help of others to fulfill His purpose. In recognition of this, BIU faculties and staffs are

committed to assisting students in their development through the relational processes of mentoring.

4. Practical Involvement: Students benefit from the opportunity to give out while they are taking in to make their learning real and meaningful. Some of the Holy Spirit's best work in us happens as we are focused on serving others. The local church provides the ideal context for this kind of "hands-on" learning. All students are expected to serve in their own local church unless they are geographically too distant.

5. Peer Relationships: Being in a close-knit community like BIU is a great advantage to someone desiring to grow. Having so many friends who are headed in similar life directions and who possess the same values is an amazing advantage when trying to stretch oneself. Mutual encouragement and accountability are great resources and often relationships formed while in BIU become strategic later in life.

IV. SPIRITUAL LIFE

Recognizing spiritual growth to be the most important key to life success, BIU places strong emphasis on this area. We seek to provide an atmosphere conducive to spiritual development. The most important area a student can grow in during their time at BIU is their personal relationship with Jesus Christ. All students are continually encouraged in their own walk with God and much of the BIU program is aimed at equipping a student's spiritual development.

A. PERSONAL DEVOTIONAL LIFE

The foundation for all spiritual experience is one's own personal relationship with God. Students are encouraged to develop a consistent, meaningful and uniquely personal devotional life. Student encouraged to

use their times to motivate their own private devotional life .Our desire is that students will leave their time at BIU with a significantly more intimate relationship with God.

ACADEMIC LIFE

The Registrar's Office will help you with a variety of functions such as course registration, registration changes (add/drop), change of programme, transfer questions, grade reports, transcripts, letter of admission, graduation issues etc. You must inform the Registrar's Office if you change your address, phone number, or email address.

A. REGISTRATION

1. Dates and Deadlines: Registration dates are included in the academic calendar published in the school brochure.

2. Eligibility: Eligibility for registration is based on the following factors. For new students, your application must have already been accepted. For returning students, you must be in good standing with the school, including having met all financial obligations from the previous semester. You may attend and receive credit only for courses for which you have been registered. Your registration will be complete upon signing and submitting your matriculation contract. The official course roster from the Registrar's Office is the only basis an instructor has for enrolling a student in their course. The only exception to this is that a student may attend a class without registering if they have already successfully completed that course for credit.

3. Auditing: Auditing is limited by the faculty. Special permission may be requested from the Dean's Office.

4. Course Cancellation Policy: BIU makes every effort to offer any course required for a programme, but may cancel a course if there is not sufficient enrollment. This is extremely rare in the case of required courses but happens occasionally with electives.

CLASS ATTENDANCE

We believe that regular class attendance is essential to your education. BIU credits reflect a strong attendance component. The faculty has adopted the following policies:

1. Students are expected to be at all classes according to the stipulated time for which they have registered. A maximum of four unexcused absences from class per semester may be permitted.

Continued unsatisfactory attendance will be sufficient grounds for dismissal from the school. Re-admission may be permitted if the student can show the Dean or Dean of Student Affairs that the problem has been resolved.

2. If a student misses fifteen minutes or more of a class, it will constitute an absence and will not be permitted to join the class until that lecture period is over.

3. Students are not permitted to leave a class before it is dismissed.

4. Items normally considered excusable are illnesses, a family wedding or a critical illness/death in the immediate family.

5. Students are responsible for class content when absent, whether excused or unexcused.

B. CLASSROOM PROTOCOL

The key to effective learning in the classroom is maintaining attention. Anything that promotes consistent, active, and participative attention

promotes learning. Anything that distracts or takes away from attention reduces learning. The following protocol for our classrooms is designed simply to increase attention and learning:

1. Please be on time and ready to learn by the beginning of the class period.

2. You may bring an appropriate non-alcohol drink with a secured lid to class. Please do not bring food.

3. Do not mark the roll sheet for other students (unless you are the designated attendance taker).

4. You may use your laptop computer, cell phone or other digital device in class only for the purpose of note taking or Bible reference. These devices are generally not allowed in the back row or sides of a classroom. Please keep your cell phone silenced during class.

5. Appropriate interaction can increase learning in the classroom. However, irrelevant conversation with classmates decreases learning. Please stay focused on the topic being discussed.

6. Please do not work on assignments or study for exams during the class period.

7. Please do not leave the classroom during the class period unless it is a biological emergency. Do not leave class early until general closing prayer.

8. Every classroom has an optimum "zone of concentration." To maximize learning, please do not sit on the periphery of the room unless necessary.

9. While it may be appropriate to study for an exam as a group, making and distributing copies of an exam review takes away the value of the review process.

10. Study notes should not be taken into an examination. If you are more than 15 minutes late for an exam, you will not be allowed to take it. All electronic devices are to be turned off during an exam.

STUDENT RECORDS

The student's academic file is handled in a confidential manner. Student records are made accessible to certain authorized state and federal personnel. School officials in the performance of their professional responsibilities may also access records.

ADMISION REQUIREMENTS

Bible Impart University is seeking future graduates with diverse interests, experiences and perspectives, ready to capture academic opportunities with creativity and enthusiasm.

Students shall be required of the following for admission:

- 3. Completion and remittance of all necessary application fees.
- 4. Official transcript of previous academic experience and satisfactory evidence of current academic ability for entry to degree programmes.
